



MENTOR AND VOLUNTEER ROLES 2022

ALL MENTORS IN THE ART OF ACCOMPANIMENT MENTORING

- Age: 31+
- Lay or Consecrated
- Religious sisters must be fully professed or in temporary vows
- 8+ years of experience in profession/vocation
- Serving as a mentor for one year (monthly meetings with a maximum of 2 mentees for a half hour minimum)
- Complimentary food and lodging at the Forum **on campus**
- Travel is also covered for consecrated women who take a vow of poverty

RETURNING MENTORS

Our definition of a returning GIVEN Mentor is a woman who was trained by Dr. Joshua Miller, attended an in-person Forum, and accompanied young women in the Art of Accompaniment Mentoring Program.

- Orientation April 4th at 1pm EST or 8pm EST
- *Optional* 4 virtual training sessions, one hour in length each
- *Optional* Letter to Women Discussion Group, one hour in length each
 - Arrival on June 20th and departure on June 25th
- *Not required to attend the Forum to mentor young women in the Art of Accompaniment year*
 - *Can choose to stay off campus if desired (at your own cost)*

NEW MENTORS

- Orientation April 4th at 1pm EST or 8pm EST
- Mandatory 4 virtual training sessions, one hour in length each
 - Arrival on June 20th and departure on June 25th
- Leading a small group at the Forum with another woman (each group is led by one consecrated and one lay woman)

EVENT VOLUNTEERS

- Ages 31+ (except religious sisters & GIVEN Alumnae)
 - Lay or Consecrated
- Arrival on June 19th and departure on June 25th
- Orientation April 4th at 1pm EST or 8pm EST
 - *Optional* 1 virtual training session
- Serving on volunteer teams such as registration table, care for the environment, liturgy, etc.
- Also, can minister in one-on-one capacities
 - Complimentary food at the Forum
- Travel and lodging is also covered for consecrated women who take a vow of poverty
