Mentors:

Prepare adequately for each meeting

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Trust the Holy Spirit to lead

PREPARE:

- 1. **Review** email correspondence, notes, and GIVEN materials prior to the meeting
- 2. Write a quick outline for the meeting

- Goals: faith-family-foundation

Let the Holy Spirit lead:

- 1. Open with prayer
- 2. Ask the mentee if she has specific questions/goals
- 3. Listen. Be humble. Get curious. Ask lots of questions.
- 4. Holy Spirit~ Help me to see what she needs from me.
- 5. Make connections that REVEAL and celebrate her unique genius.

MENTOR	ACTION PLAN STRATEGIST
Meets regularly with mentee	Meets only once or twice
Accompanies mentee through action plan launch	Provides targeted support for part of the action plan
Does not need to have expertise in all aspects of mentee's action plan	Needs to have expertise in particular aspect of mentee's action plan
Helps mentee see action plan in light of strengths and charisms	Helps mentee move forward with part of action plan, without particular attention to strengths/charisms
Primary interactions are relationship-based	Primary interactions are skills and results based
